Report of the County Archivist West Glamorgan Archives Committee 18 March 2016

The purpose of this report is to outline the work of the Archive Service during the period December 2015 to February 2016

1. Archive Service budget 2016/17

As outlined at the December meeting and detailed above in the 2016/17 Revenue Budget report, in line with the programme *Sustainable Swansea: Fit for the Future*, a reduction of £36,000 has been made in the 2016/17 budget on that of 2015/16 which equates operationally to the loss of one assistant archivist post and that of a part-time paraprofessional.

The consequences of the loss of the two posts above are that the West Glamorgan Archive Service staffing contribution to the Neath Antiquarian Society Archives will reduce from its current level of four days to two days a week. The precise details of how the reduced WGAS contribution will affect the opening hours at the facility remain to be discussed with the Neath Antiquarian Society.

The 2016/17 budget cut will leave the Service with a staff complement of 8.0 FTE covering 47 hours of public opening per week in Swansea and Neath. A further cut to the budget in 2017/18 of £24,000 will see the non-salaries budget cut by 50%, one consequence being that the Archive Service will no longer have a core budget to carry out repair or conservation work to its collections other than by grant application to external funders.

2. Commissioning

As part of the *Sustainable Swansea* programme, Swansea Council is implementing a number of savings-producing strategies over the next three years, including assessing services for commissioning and in-house transformation to meet financial and service demands with reduced resources.

On 23 February, the Council issued a prior information notice (PIN) for its cultural and leisure services. Interest is being sought from third parties, including not-for-profit and community-based companies and organisations, to work in partnership with Swansea Council. The Archive Service has been included in the marketplace testing, following consultation with senior officers and members from Neath Port Talbot Council. Both parent authorities will consider the next steps to be taken for the Archive Service once the deadline for response has passed, which may include some form of non-profit distributing organisation, a cross-sectoral partnership or transformation in-house.

2. West Wales Regional Archives Partnership

A further piece of consultancy work is currently taking place to develop the West Wales Regional Archives Partnership proposal to RIBA Stage 0. This work has been funded through a Welsh Government grant. A provisional report will be made available to the partners by the end of March.

3. Ancestry website

A contract with major family history website company Ancestry to digitise name-rich archive collections and make them available on a pay-per-view basis on the Ancestry website was signed in December. The records to be imaged include electoral registers, prison and poor law records.

The company has recruited a camera operator locally and filming is due to start on 8 March. The work will last approximately three months with an expected publication date on the Ancestry website of April 2017.

4. Use of the Service

5. Service outreach

The Service is a partner in the new University-led project entitled 'Visions of Steel' to work with various communities in Port Talbot (including Sandfields Comprehensive School) on a newly-discovered set of historic glass slides from the Abbey Steelworks.

Marketing awards

The Archive Service won the all-Wales archives marketing excellence award for a third time in four years, in an award scheme sponsored by Welsh Government for Welsh museums, archives and libraries to demonstrate innovation and good marketing. The award was for the creation and marketing of the digital resource 'Swansea in 1852'. The Cynefin project to digitise the tithe maps of Wales won the award for joint marketing project of the year (WGAS chairs the Project Board).

The Service has been awarded a grant of £16,600 for conservation work to the Neath Abbey Ironworks collection by the National Manuscripts Conservation Trust with support from Welsh Government. The work will be undertaken by Gwynedd Archives Conservation Unit.

The Service has taken in a number of records from the DVLA for onward distribution to archives across the UK working on behalf of The National Archives.
