


I am informed by Mr. Duffield of the Western Divisional Surveyors Office that you are concerned about the route of the above right of way which passes through your property. The enclosed extract from the 1915 Ordnance Survey Map clearly indicates the route, and you will see that it does, in fact, pass through the portion of land presently occupied by the remains of an old greenhouse.

Clearance of overgrowth undertaken by T.C.C. team.
In course of clearance, part of remains of greenhouse have
been removed. The landowner (Mr & Mrs G Griffiths, 33, Bernard Street,
Pontard, Swansea) claim that the path is not shown on their
titles and that the path does not pass over the land on
which the greenhouse was built. However, the 1915 edition of the
Ordnance Survey map does show the original line of the path, and when
this line is superimposed on the modern O.S. map, it does indicate that
the path covers the land on which the remains of the greenhouse stand.
