Mayhill Integrated Primary Care and Family Centre

This letter follows a proposal submitted by the City and County of Swansea ("the Council") on 8th April 2016 detailing a request to extend the funding period for the delivery of the Primary Care and Family Centre in Mayhill into 2016/2017.

The award of funding of £400,000 provided by the Welsh Ministers for the Mayhill Primary Care and Family Centre was contained within a funding award letter dated 27th June 2012.

Having considered the Council's request, I can confirm the Welsh Ministers are agreeable to extending the period of the award to 31st March 2017. Please be aware however, this is the last occasion on which Welsh Government Officials will seek approval from Welsh Ministers to consider extending this award of funding.

All other terms and conditions provided in the funding award letter dated 27th June 2012 will remain in full force, subject to this agreed variation.
