(b) Please name and describe below Development and externalisation of a food enterprise Community Interest Company. Since 2012, the number of people experiencing hunger has risen in Swansea, with parents reporting going hungry in order to feed their children, and the number of food bank parcels distributed increasing year on year. Swansea Council's Community Food and Growing Team have been supporting residents through a network of external partners since 2003, tackling food poverty alongside poverty of access to good food and lack of skills and knowledge around food preparation. With the effect of austerity measures impacting partner organisations and residents, and grant funding for projects being short term in nature and becoming harder to come by, Swansea Council have been searching for innovative ways to better support our residents to overcome barriers to affordable and nutritious food. The team have spent more than a year identifying and developing a new, sustainable, community-based approach to tackling food poverty in Swansea, through the development and externalisation of a Community Interest Company which produces and sells high quality, good value meals. This new service has been trialled following support from Cabinet in April 2016, and is now delivering food services in Swansea. The team are now preparing to take a further report to Cabinet in order to plan for the enterprise to externalise
