Section 1: Constituency activities

I held surgeries for all Dunvant residents each month from 10 am – 11 am in Dunvant Social Centre. I was and continue to be available by email – cllr.jennifer.raynor@swansea.gov.uk or by telephone 01792 207807 and at the Guildhall on 637429.

Issues raised this past year include dangerous parking on pavements, blocking the way for pedestrians. Inconsiderate parking near Dunvant Primary, blocking in local residents who want to go to work. Parents in cars not looking out for other children on foot when they try and park and pull off. This is a serious issue and PCSO's have visited the school.

Residents asked me to improve traffic safety on Dunvant Bridge by providing a white line in the centre of the bridge. The white line was painted on the road.

I have used my Councillor's Environmental Allowance to extend the planting of wildflowers within the Dunvant area. I contributed some of my allowance towards the grant application for play equipment made by the Friends of Dunvant Park. At the Meadow Playground, I arranged for the surface to be improved and paid for the installation of the junior zip wire. I have made donations to Dunvant and Pen Y Fro Primary Schools. I have made donations to Dunvant Social Centre and to the Horticultural Club towards running community activities.

At the request of residents concerned about road safety, I used my allowance to install School Warning Amber Flashing Lights (SWAFL's) on Goetre Fawr Road near the junction with Dunvant Road. I paid for the Traffic Regulation Order at Y Berllan.

I am a member of the Friends of Dunvant Park group. I attend their meetings regularly and liaise with relevant Cabinet Members on issues, which the Friends Group raised.

I attended Police and Communities Together (PACT) meetings and was (and still am) in regular contact with our Police Community Support Officers (PCSO's).

I was (and continue to be) a Governor at Pen-y-Fro Primary School and Olchfa Comprehensive School.
