# **Section 1: Constituency activities**

Together with my fellow Cockett Ward Councillor I carry out monthly street surgeries around the ward.

I continue to be a Governor at both Waunarlwydd Primary School and Ysgol Login Fach Primary School both of whom received positive Estyn inspections.

I have worked closely with the parent, the Head Teacher and the education department to secure funding to enable Ysgol Login Fach to accommodate more pupils.

I am a Trustee at Waunarlwydd Community Centre and attended regular monthly meetings.

I also attended regular Pact meetings around the ward and work closely with the Police to address issues such as anti-social behaviour, dog fouling, traffic, issues and illegal parking.

I am working closely with residents in Gendros to secure funding for a fence around the children's play area and I am continuing to work with residents in Waunarlwydd to address traffic issue on Victoria and Bryn road.

In addition to the above I have dealt with numerous constituent enquires cover issues such as; traffic issues, anti-social behaviour, tenancy issues, housing allocation, fly-tipping, dog fouling, refuse collection, noise nuisance, residents parking and complaints to the Council.
