Section 1: Constituency activities

I have continued to work hard representing the people of Gorseinon. I have held regular surgeries on the first Saturday of Every month at the Constituency Office, 9 Pontardulais Road. During winter 2015/16 the Gorseinon Matters newsletter was written and distributed by myself along with the Swansea Matters Leaflet. This year I have worked to provide additional wild flowers and have increased the number of hanging baskets at Llwchwr Workingman's Club (the Bug) and Gorsienon Workingman's Club (the Brighton Road Club). I have worked with the clubs to provide Heart Defibrillator's at each of the Clubs, providing an additional lifesaving resource to our community. Gorseinon Primary School - I was very pleased that after a long and successful campaign. Swansea Planning Committee approved plans in December for a 21st Century Primary School and improved fit for purpose Park at Parc v Werin, improving the education and play arrangements for our children for many years to come. In addition, I arranged for the School Council to visit the Guildhall in Swansea for a 'mini-debate' and tour. Gorseinon Skate Park - I am continuing to work with officers, residents, businesses, town council and young people to bring a Skate Board Park to Parc Melin Mynach. Working with DVLA – I organised an away day for DVLA Managers to attend the Guildhall. Friends of Gorseinon Parks – I have worked with the Town Council to provide a grant to support the Parc Y Werin Committee. I worked with Cabinet members on providing a guide for new 'friends of' initiatives. Wild Flowers - I have continued to work with Swansea and Gorseinon Town Council to ensure the successful wild flowers campaign is continued throughout the Town and Parks. Highways Issues – I meet regularly with Highways Officers, addressing safety and parking issues. I have implemented a number of dropped curb and safety lines throughout the town. I am continuing the campaign to reduce waiting times at Gorseinon traffic lights. Gorseinon Events – I continue to be a supporter of Gorseinon's 2 major events – Gorseinon Christmas Parade and Gorseinon Carnival. These annual events cover summer and winter, providing a huge boost to the town and help to keep community spirit strong. I am extremely proud of all the people involved, who give many hours of their time to ensure that the events continue to be a success. Building and Improving Strong Relationships - I have been working to ensure that strong relationships are held with Swansea Council, Gorseinon Town Council, Gorseinon Chamber of Trade and Gorseinon Development Trust. Working together with the Police – I meet quarterly with the Police inspector for Gorseinon. Retirement **Complexes** – As often as I can, I meet with the residents of Llys Gwalia, Llys y Werin, Einon Court and Cwrt Hywel, listening to concerns and addressing any issues (where possible). Gorseinon Gateway Monday Club - I continue to support this charity and have helped to Secure further much needed grants this year.
