Section 1: Constituency activities

Working with my colleague Cllr Joe Hale, we have held monthly Cllr surgeries on the first Saturday of each month. These were held at various locations across St Thomas namely Port Tennant Community Centre, St Thomas Church Hall, Fabians Bay Church Hall and Gwyn Mission.

We also held 2 residents meetings at St Thomas Church Hall and Gwyn Mission. Council Officers attended both meetings to discuss local concerns about traffic and parking. We attempted to make Residents Meetings more community focussed and also had representation from the local Police. We produced 3 local newsletters in March, September and December 2013.

I was a Governor of both St Thomas Community School and Danygraig School.

We dealt with a wide range of local individual issues ranging from Residents Parking, Dog Fouling, Cleaning of rear lanes, Lifting traffic restrictions to help local businesses on Port Tennant Road, Road Safety matters, Planning issues and Housing requests.

I played an active role in Port Tennant Communities First Partnership and attended regular monthly meetings. I assisted the local GSP Community Partnership by attending monthly meetings and assisting with organisation of Eastside Carnival.

We re-formed the Tir John Landfill Site Residents Committee and established a good working relationship between the Local Community and Council Officers. I established quarterly meetings with the City & County of Swansea Eastside Housing Office.
