## Section 1: Constituency activities

I have held monthly evening surgeries at the Welfare Hall, Loughor and taken part in 'street surgeries' throughout Upper Loughor in 2017-18. I also attended coffee mornings which provided opportunities for residents to meet with local Councillors. In addition, I have supported local events held by Llwchwr Town Council, St David's Church, Penuel Chapel, Moriah Chapel, Tre-Uchaf Primary School, Ysgol Gymraeg Pontybrenin, Loughor RFC, and Loughor Workingmen's Club.

I represented residents' views on major planning applications. I have also discussed road safety issues with residents and officers and have requested a number of traffic speed surveys in the area. This year saw the completion of work to improve the safety of the junction of Danybryn Road and Alexandra Road, Loughor. At the same time, I have worked with officers to resolve issues preventing the use of the path from North Road to Tre-uchaf school. I am pleased that remedial works have been carried out by the landowner and will be working to ensure that any remaining issues are addressed.

I have assisted fund-raising events held by Loughor Town Trust and Loughor RFC. In addition to the above, I have represented individual householders' concerns to a range of Council departments. These have included matters relating to parking, drainage, public transport, fly tipping, parks management, and environmental improvements.
