## Section 1: Constituency activities

I attended monthly PACT meetings and took up issues raised with officers and delivered a regular six weekly newsletter to every home in the ward.

Together with my fellow ward Councillors we took up a number of issues. These included: 1. Sorted out landscaping around the carpark for Burlais School

- 2. Got Coastal HA to clear fly-tipping in the lane behind Millwood Street
- 3. Worked with PATCH Team to have large numbers of potholes repaired
- 4. Had Richard Street and section of Courtney Street made one-way
- 5. Working with drainage section to tackle flooding problems in Eaton Road
- 6. Had residents parking installed in Manor Road, lorwerth Street and Lynn Street
- 7. Installed wildflower beds in St. John's Road, Maesglas Road and Pentregethin Road
- 8. Had new earth bank at bottom of Middle Road landscaped
- 9. Had fly-tipping removed from behind Maesglas House
- 10. Had communal benches in Llwyncethin Road painted

11. Helped Community Centre management team to replace fencing and defective guttering

- 12. Turned bus shelter around in Eaton Road to tackle Anti-social behaviour
- 13. Worked with NEAT Team to cut back and tidy back lanes, land by Cwmbwrla roundabout and at bottom of Vicarage Lane

14. Put new bollard and railings on corner David Street and Cae Rowlands to stop vehicles mounting pavement

- 15. Put new street light into Verig Street
- 16. Pressed for drying areas in Maesglas flats to be resurfaced
- 17. Had no waiting orders out on roads by Burlais and Brynhyfryd Schools
- 18. Had new flooring put in common areas in flats at 60-66 and 52-58 Brondeg Crescent

19. Had lane from Elgin Street to St. John's House resurfaced, new handrail and lighting installed.

## Section 2: Councillor attendance at selected Council body meetings

Attendance at Council body meetings is only one of the important elements of a Councillor's duties. Councillors are also active by holding surgeries, attending meetings and dealing with general electoral division enquiries.

On the council I worked with my colleagues to oppose the 13% increase in the cost of school meals over the next three years, to fight the £40 a day charge for those attending day centres, to stop the axing of some local youth clubs and to oppose the 5% increase in council tax. We proposed to add £450,000 to the road repair budget but this was voted down in council.
