In addition, the Transforming Towns/ Target Regeneration Investment Programme Property Enhancement Development Grant, Sustainable Living Grants and Green Infrastructure grants (which are providing the funding for actions within the plan) have all been subject to their own equalities impact assessments and grant recipients are required to adhere to equal opportunities policy as a condition of their grant funding when delivering these activities.

For other actions within the plan, the impact on protected groups will be considered as the proposals develop, and all will be screened and full IIAs will be undertaken if appropriate in the future as the action plan progresses.
