Objection to licence application for the Ponderosa wine bar, 628 Munibles Road.

My trother and 9 jointly own no 2 Hallbank Terrace, which is my mother's home. She is 93 and not in good health but enjoys living quietry in a residential area which is part of the Mumbles consentation area and the Uillage have character area.

We have examined and object to the licence application. with regard to the application document we note that :-

- . Part 3 appears to show that the applicant untends to provide live and recorded rusice but boxes E and F have not boan completed. For the avoidance of doubt we assume that rusic is proposed. However, the premises are tusic is proposed. However, the premises are too small for two music and any music too small for two music and any music would be a nuiscance for neighbouring properties
- . Box I indicates that late right refreshment would be supplied indoors and outdoors, but there is no outside space available other than the highway.
- Box M & indicates reliance on CCTU, but its use is primarily involved after an incident has taken place. Door supervision should be specified rather than relying on the licence holder's assessment. Friday to Sunday nights, school holidays and the summer period should be included.

· Box Md. Notices are of limited use, especially when alcohol has been consimed and on past experience, will be ignored.

Green the proximity to our property, bottles " particular should not be moved etc after 9 pm.

The storage bins should to test in the rear Storage area, not on the highway.

The previous owners ran the premoes as a restaurant and did not cause any problems other than cooking smells.

A wine bor will attract a different custoner and the consumpteon of alcohol will nevitably result in anti social bohaviour particularly affecting the Hallback Terrace, Rockhill and Village have residential area. The problems arising from the former Antelope Hotel resulted in many complants and descussion with the Council and Folice to establish effective control rocasures.

We do not want to see a return of the Membles mile mentallity. For example, since Elvoyn's storted take away alcohol sales recontly we had people unnating on the steps in Rockhill in see middle of a Sunday

We are concerned that granting the licence afternoon. well result in nuiscause and antisocial behaviour including !-

- . Nouse and cooking smalls for longer periods
- . Street drinking and snotting

- · Urnation and comiting on the highway, Perticularly Hallbank Terrace, Rockfull and Village Lane.
 - · houd music
 - · Disordary bahaviour affecting residents returning home, particularly women and after dark.
 - · Obstructeon of Orlage hour by delivery volicies.
 - · Use of the side door in Village Land would be a traffice hazard for constoners particularly when stepping outside having consumed alcohol.
 - . Storage of ting on the highway
 - . Litter in general
