<b>1</b>	<p><b>Councillor C A Holley</b></p> <p><b>In relation to Minute - Councillors Questions - Question 1</b></p> <p>Councillor C A Holley stated that following the closure of the Felindre Works the former Welsh Development Agency and former Lliw Valley Borough Council owned the brown field and green field site totalling approximately 750 acres. This land was earmarked for a 750-acre Business Park.</p> <p>The Business Park now only equates to approximately 150 acres with the remaining land allocated as land for housing under the Local Development Plan (LDP).</p> <p>When was the decision made to remove the land from Business Park use and why.</p> <p><b>Response of the Cabinet Member for Environment Enhancement &amp; Infrastructure Management</b></p> <p>The information required to respond to this question has been requested from our Joint Venture partners in Welsh Government.
