Report of the County Archivist West Glamorgan Archives Committee 22 July 2022

The purpose of this report is to outline the work of the Archive Service during the period March to May 2022

1. Neath service point reopening

The service point in the Neath Mechanics Institute reopened on Monday 25 April with a service on Mondays only, allowing public access to the archive collections held there. The Neath Antiquarian Society are providing a parallel service for its members on a Thursday morning using volunteers. There has been an issue with the broadband connection at the site which remains unresolved at time of writing and which has meant that a service for family historians has not been possible since reopening.

2. Use of the Service

3. National Broadcast Archive

As reported last quarter, the Family History Centre in Swansea will be the location for a 'Clip Corner' or access point for the archives of several Welsh television companies (BBC Wales, S4C and HTV Wales) via the National Library of Wales (NLW), which holds the original broadcast tapes. A portion of the Family History Centre has been cleared and redecorated ready for rebranding as a small extension of the NLW held on a peppercorn lease (this is necessary because of rights issues for the archive film footage). Following some delays, it is anticipated that this facility will open in September as one of the first Clip Corners in Wales.

4. Relocation of the archives

A decision in principle to relocate the Archive Service to the City Centre Hub was taken by Swansea Council's Cabinet in December last year, however Neath Port Talbot Council has yet to formally approve the proposed transfer of its archives.

At the time of writing this report, the City Centre Hub project has passed RIBA Stage 3, which relates to spatial co-ordination within the building. A detailed floorplan has been developed which places the archive searchroom on the first floor and the archive strongroom on the second (top) floor, the latter connected to the former by a document lift. The new searchroom has seating for ten people at document tables, three seated at PC desks and one using a microfilm reader.

RIBA Stage 4 relates to technical design, and a number of challenges remain as to how the archive strongroom will maintain environmental stability in accordance with BS 4971.

5. Outreach and educational activity

There has been no outreach work or activity with schools during the quarter, other than regular social media posts.
