99. To Confer the Honorary Freedom of the City and County of Swansea to Kevin Johns MBE.

The Lord Mayor welcomed the Deputy Lord Lieutenant, High Sheriff, Civic Dignitaries, Distinguished Guests, Members of the Council and Kevin Johns to the Ceremonial Meeting of Council.

The Leader of the Council referred to the meeting of Council held on 3 November 2022 (Minute 79 refers) whereby Council resolved to confer the Honorary Freedom of the City and County of Swansea to Kevin Johns.

The Leader of Council, the Leader of the Largest Opposition Political Group and the other Political Group Leaders spoke in support of the motion.

Kevin Johns was born in Plasmarl, Swansea and is a well-known face of entertainment. He has dedicated his life to entertainment and charity. Kevin Johns has been dubbed "Mr Swansea" and in recent years he topped the vote of Swansea Icons.

Resolved that the Honorary Freedom of the City and County of Swansea be conferred on Kevin Johns.

The Lord Mayor presented Kevin Johns with the Honorary Freedom Scroll, granting him the Freedom of the City and County of Swansea.

Kevin Johns responded by thanking the Council for the honour.
