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Street Cleansing teams will be impacted by their ability to collect/empty incorrectly used reusable containers. This potential issue already exists for the reusable plastic bag, so Cleansing will be able to readily adapt to other reusable containers.

The switch to reusable containers for selected waste streams will help meet the Council's aim to reduce single use plastic wherever possible. Consideration has been/will be given to the needs of both residents and collection operatives to ensure containers are appropriate for householders and safe for employees. The proposal will not impact the resident's ability to recycle and will not pass on costs to residents.
