Section 1: Constituency activities

I have been active in my ward over the past year. Working closely with my ward colleagues I have held regular advice surgeries, attended community meetings and helped resolve a number of key local issues.

This included dealing with the issue of 'Legal Highs' where we supported strong action by the police and trading standards and stopped the supply of legal highs in Woodfield Street.

Together with ward colleagues we funded and organised the Christmas lights parade and celebrations, and also funded wild flowers and flower displays throughout the ward during the summer months.

We worked to implement parking schemes and traffic calming measures on a number of roads, replaced lighting columns, and funded the purchase and installation of a number of bus shelters at bus stops across the ward.

I have also spoken on a number of local planning applications during the year relaying and representing resident's views on planning matters.

I have continued to support local groups and organisations, and have attended a number of fund raisers and concerts during the year.
