Section 1: Constituency activities

I had a full workload consisting of concerns & complaints made by residents of the Mynyddbach Ward. Those concerns included Housing, litter, and youths on bikes, neighbours disputes, car parking, fly tipping, and potholes amongst others.

I dealt with all my cases by e-mail & visited resident's homes when invited to do so. I attended regular Pact meetings & School Governors meetings in the ward. I have a good working relationship with District Housing staff & Managers. The Police Community Support Officers (PCSO'S) often visited me at my home to give me details of any incidents that were occurring in the Ward.

My ward of Mynyddbach was and continues to be a hot spot for tethered horses. I joined a local voluntary organisation called Friends of Swansea Horses which campaigns against the tethering of horses in Swansea. I am currently attempting to collect funds for this worthy cause.

This past year was extremely busy for me as one of the ward Councillors was on Mayoral duties. The second Councillor has been unwell at various times of the year. The workload increased dramatically however I got through without any assistance from the Administration. I doubled up the number of surgeries I attended as I covered for Councillor Ceinwen Thomas's surgeries too. The number of surgeries I held was 2 out of every 4 weeks.

I have made a great deal of progress in the Ward however there is still a long way to go. I have problems with 2 roads in the Ward and I am working with the relevant Cabinet member to try & resolve the issues of speeding traffic. Consideration is being given to replacing the current traffic measures which are no longer fit for purpose.

I had bollards placed in a number of areas in the Ward to prevent cars from parking on grass verges & pavements. These were welcomed by both businesses & residents.
