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Section 1: Constituency activities

General constituency issues - I dealt with many local problems such as pot holes, sink holes, rubbish collections and flooding etc. I provided advice and support on a number of individual issues and referred items to council officers on a wide range of topics. Always available at home, by telephone or email and will visit constituents at their homes if it is more convenient for them.

Monthly surgeries – I held surgeries each month at Pennard Parish Hall and Pennard Produce Market. {The dates and venues have changed for 2014/15, the surgeries will be in Pennard Library and at Pennard Produce Market on the second Saturday and Sunday of each month between 10.30 am– 12.00 pm}

PACT meetings – I regularly attended the PACT meetings organised by Pennard Neighbourhood Watch with the local Police Officer and PSO. These meetings included specific issues such as the local bus services, speeding, roaming cattle to which relevant people were invited.

Newsletters – I produced and delivered regular newsletters to all constituents covering topics relevant to the Pennard Ward which I believed would be of interest.

Planning – I reviewed all planning applications for the ward and visited the majority of the sites. I called in contentious applications to go to committee, consulted planning officers and contacted enforcement officers when considered necessary.

Pennard Community Council - I attended the majority of the community council meetings and took forward issues raised in that forum. As a member of the community council I took an active lead in many of the community projects such as the rebuilding of the playing field pavilion.

Pennard Library - I arranged public meetings to object to the closure of Pennard Library and to secure the continuation of the excellent librarian-led service. From these meetings the Friends of Pennard Library (FoPL) group was formed, which is now working with Swansea Council to upgrade the present library building and to make the library service in Pennard sustainable for the future.

Car Parking - To discourage indiscriminate car parking in Southgate, I worked with the National Trust to encourage greater use of their car park by implementing cheaper car parking for short stays. Also a special initiative for local residents on National Trust Membership to enable them to park for free.
