I have given financial help to Gowerton Rugby Club to move the pedestrian entrance for safety and replace the fence to improve the visual aspect at the entrance of the village. I continue to monitor parking issues at Fairwood Terrace.

Assisted Gowerton Library History Group to apply for planning to establish history boards around the village.

Tried to progress the creation of a" Patients Forum" at the Doctors Surgery.

As safety measure the fencing around the canal in the Elba was installed & paid for out of my Community budget.

I had additional play equipment installed in the Park at Park Road.

Additional parking provision established at Llys Elba for the residents who have cars.

I regularly dealt with individual issues for residents, dog fouling complaints, Japanese knotweed, tree problems and housing requests.
