The four green infrastructure projects have been prepared by partner organisations and the funding applications were submitted by Swansea Council to WG on their behalf. All projects will help increase green infrastructure in the city centre in line with the draft Swansea Central Area Green Infrastructure Strategy - *Regenerating Our City for Wellbeing and Wildlife* (due to be adopted in 2020). The strategy was a partnership between the Council and Natural Resources Wales and was developed with public / private / 3rd sector and public involvement. To inform the strategy over 630 face to face conversations were held with members of the public across 10 locations in the Swansea Central Area, sessions were held with the 4 primary schools within the catchment and stakeholder meetings with 6 local groups including residents and local interest groups. There was overwhelming support for more nature in the city, including trees, plants flowers and water features and many people spoke of the positive emotional benefits / feeling of happiness and calmness they felt by being in or near nature. These projects will directly support this.
