Further, it is hoped this development will support in providing information to members of the public to support themselves with technology e.g. by purchasing appropriate equipment, thereby directing them from the front door of Social Services for longer. Across all three groups, this initiative could have an impact on supporting individuals to live independently in their own homes for longer. These will all be considered in the development of the Assistive Technology Strategy.
